

## **Guidelines for application to the WFNS Accreditation Committee for the Board Certification Examination**

All neurosurgeons who have a national board certification could apply for the Board Certification of the WFNS Accreditation Committee.

The following documents are required:

1. complete CV
2. diploma of medicine
3. diploma from the national board in neurosurgery
4. evidence of scientific publications
5. evidence of presentations at neurosurgical meetings

The applicant should have published (as first author) at least 1 article in international journals or at least 3 articles in national specialized journals. At least 1 presentation at an international neurosurgical meeting is also required. The applicant has to attest to a member of the Accreditation Committee, their practical skills at their working place, including case analysis, treatment selection and surgical performance.

In order to pass the oral/written examination, profound knowledge in both basic and applied neurosurgery, as well as in appropriate ancillary specialities, is required..

The Board examinations are planned to start in 2008.

The Guidelines for application will be announced as soon as possible on the WFNS website.
