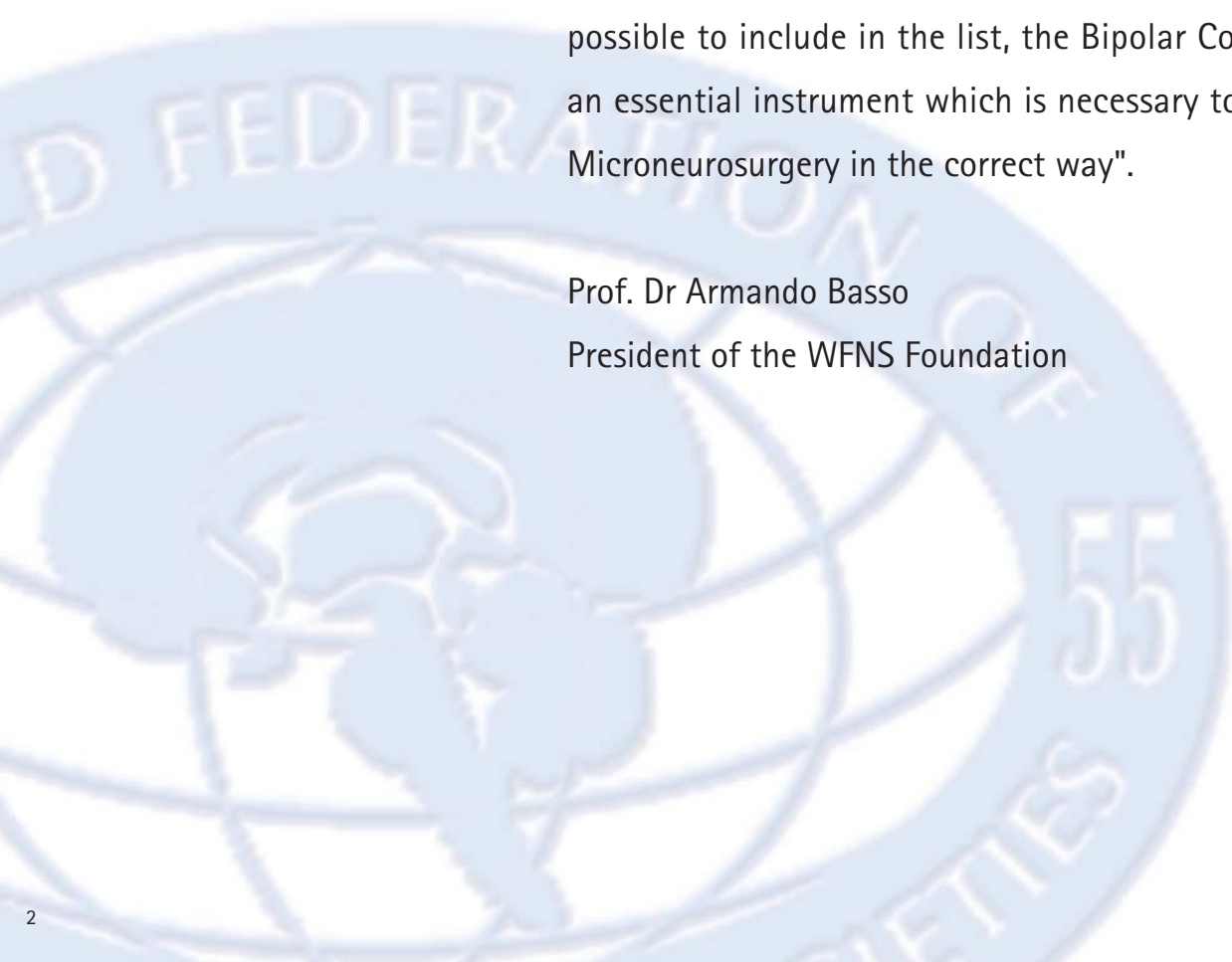

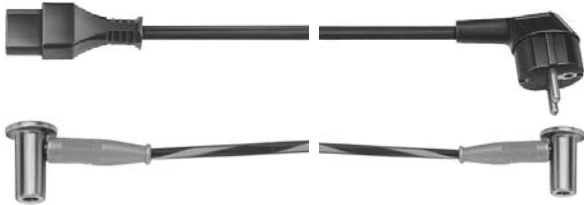




Bipolar Electrosurgical Unit

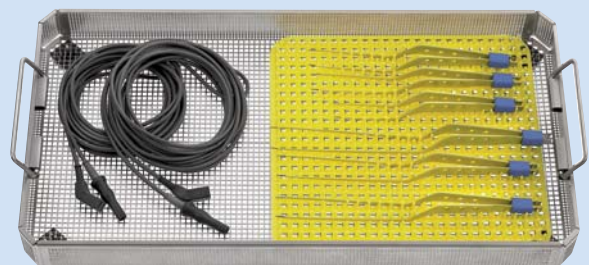


Bipolar connecting cable, 5 m

Basic Set of Bipolar Coagulation Handling of Order, Payment and Delivery

- 1) The applicant sends his application to Mrs Jan Joseph, Director, WFNS Central Office, by mentioning the sponsor's and consignee's addresses. The Director will then forward the Criteria to be fulfilled and a Questionnaire to be filled in, dated and signed and returned to the Central Office, together with a letter of support from the President of the Society of which the applicant is a member.
